The country is struck by multiple droughts over the centuries, pushing the inhabitants to take refuge in New England to flee the famine. After extensive fought against the dictator Salazar, the Capverdiens get their independence in 1975, but the country is still hard hit by the drought, and must call a few years later to the international food aid. Since the first multiparty elections in 1991, successive governments have encouraged the growth of Cape Verde, which has not been among the least developed countries since 2004, and which is part of the World Trade Organization since 2008.
